

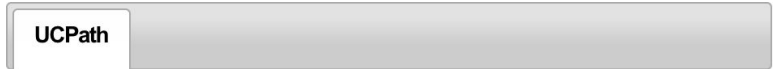
Accessing your Pay Stubs on UCPATH

Why do you need access to your Pay Stubs?

→ You need to upload documents of your pay stubs from the last 30 days for the Calfresh Application. All UC student workers can access these on [UCPath](#).

Logging onto [UCPath](#)

- Select your Respective UC Campus (in our case, UC San Diego)
- For UCSD, log into using SSO (single sign on) with your UCSD email address and password.
- If this is your first time logging in, the website will prompt you to create 5 security questions and answers.

- You can now view your pay stubs, and you can download the PDF attachment of the pay stubs required to submit for your Calfresh Application (all pay stubs from the last 30 days) by clicking on the following icon:
